

**BRETRY PARISH COUNCIL**  
**MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE PARISH HELD**

**Minutes of the Previous Annual Meeting of the Parish:** The Minutes of the Annual Meeting of the Parish held 5<sup>th</sup> May 2010 were approved and signed as a correct record.

**Matters Arising:** No matters were raised.

**Report by Chairman (Mr Falder)**

The Parish Council welcomed the works that are underway at the Knights Lane/Newton Lane junction. The hedge has been removed and the works will be completed before the autumn. The Parish Council thanked the County Council for funding and carrying out the works.

The most significant event has been the the heavy and prolonged snow falls during 2010 and 2011. This identified a need for additional grit boxes and a request for two grit boxes to be installed within the Parish has been made. The County Council were commended for keeping Geary Lane, The Mount and Knights Lane well gritted and even Bretby Lane, that is not included on the gritting route, was accessible.

The barrier/gate on Hospital Drive has now materialised. The condition of the drive from the village to the Hall continues to be poor.

The Parish Council continues to press for an extension of the speed limit on Bretby Lane and for a pavement to the Nurseries. The deep gullies along the edge of Bretby Lane have not been attended to, the County Council maintaining that that there is no problem. The Parish Council disagrees and will continue to press for repairs to the carriageway.

Mr Falder thanked all Councillors and the Clerk for their hard work and assistance during the year. On behalf of the Parish Council he expressed special thanks to Mrs Wheeler MP, who has made the decision not to re-stand as a Parish Councillor. She will be missed, particularly as she regularly kept all up to date with relevant information on policies etc.

**Questions from the Floor**

A Parishioner reported that part of the Bretby Lane pavement has been resurfaced, but repairs carried out by various utility companies have already made the pavement patchy and uneven in parts.

There being no further business, the Chairman thanked everyone for their attendance and closed the meeting at 7.12pm.
