**1. Chairman's report for 2015/16**

Cllr Falder reported the overriding problem remains the drainage within the parish, particularly along Bretby Lane. This has been ongoing since 1999.

The drainage along Watery Lane received some major work by the County Council and has successfully coped with water runoff. Assistance is now being sought to resolve the flooding problems on Geary Lane.

There has been two litter picks carried out by SDDC within the village. The Parish Council is very pleased with the work carried out but sadly litter very quickly accumulated.

Concerns about the speed limit at Mount Road/Bretby Lane continue. These concerns have increased with the success of the Garden Centre, as this has generated additional traffic along the lane. It is thought that it will only be a matter of time before a serious accident occurs.

An expression of thanks was given to Parish Councillors and to the Clerk for the work undertaken during the last year.
