Report by the Chairman (Cllr Falder)

The Parish Council conveyed its thanks and appreciation to the County Council on finally improving the junction at the top of Newton Lane and Knights Lane, the result is a vast improvement in the visibility at the junction. The Parish Council is continuing in its efforts to relocate the 30mph speed limit on Bretby Lane.

The forthcoming Diamond Jubilee Celebrations are keenly awaited. As part of the celebrations, the Mount has been planted and if there is any surplus funds from the Jubilee celebrations, the funds will go towards the tree maintenance programme and towards a new noticeboard.

The new website is available and is proving useful. The Parish Council is keen to receive feedback from users as to how it can be made more useful to any users.

Thanks were extended to Mr S Toone of Bretby Lane for re-establishing the Neighbourhood Watch Scheme on Bretby Lane. Members of the Neighbourhood Watch Scheme are entitled to 10% discount on their house insurance. Co-ordinators for other areas of the Parish are actively being sought.

Mr Falder thanked all the Councillors and the Clerk for their hard work and assistance during the year.
